

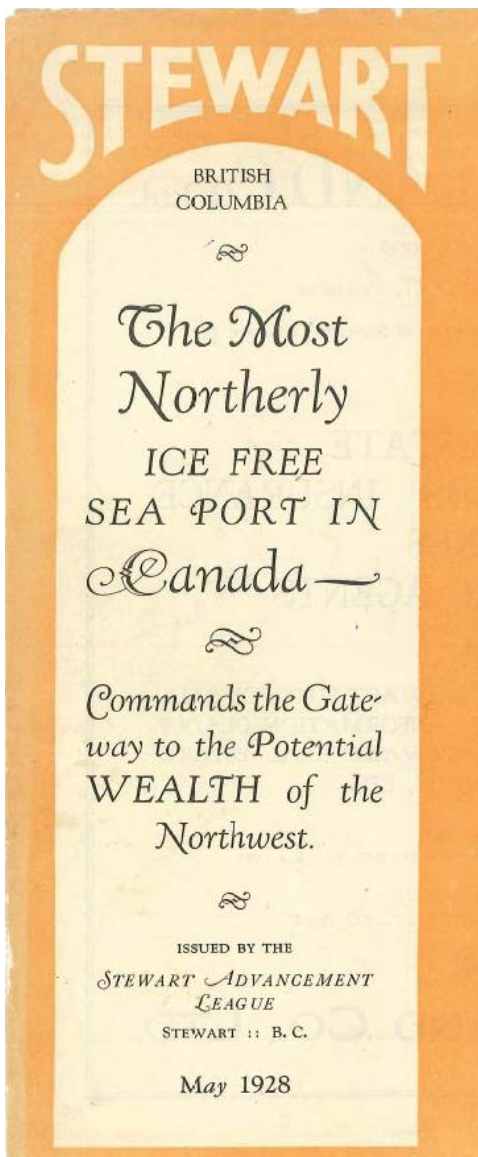
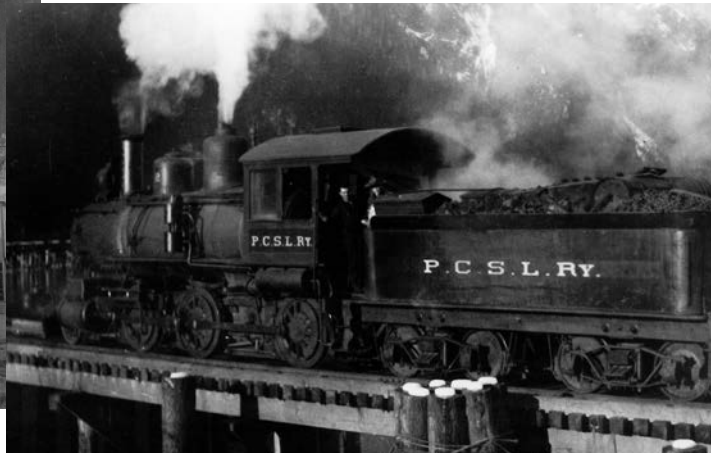

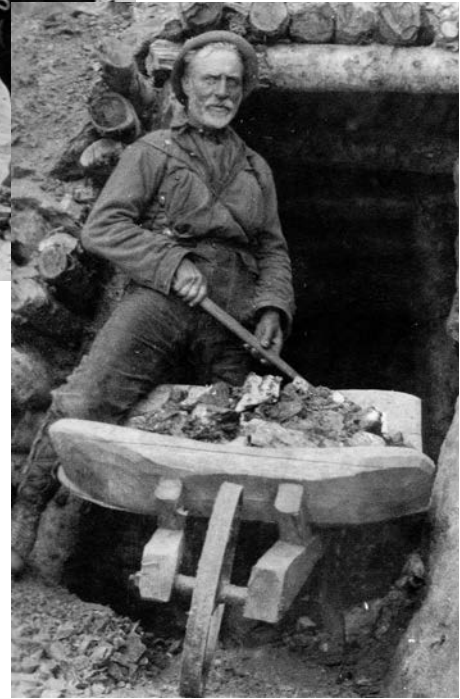
In its early years, Stewart boasted a population of 10,000.
